Governor to host historic peace summit

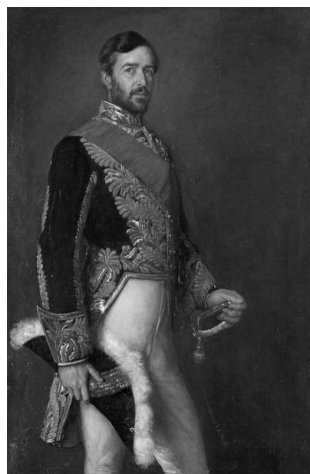
